

Connell Foley Counsel John B. LaVecchia Award to be Presented on September 28 to a senior member of the American Board of Trial Advocates – Andy Karp

Connell Foley Partner and Vice President of the American Board of Trial Advocates Brian Steller (ABOTA), will welcome and present an ABOTA senior member, Andy Karp, with the John B. LaVecchia award. The award is named after Connell Foley Counsel John B. LaVecchia who was the ABOTA's first chapter president.

A Stone Scholar at Columbia Law School, Mr. LaVecchia served as a member of the Supreme Court Fee Arbitration Committee in 1978-1979 and the Supreme Court Ethics Committee Essex District in 1981-1986. He is a member of the Essex County, New Jersey State and American Bar Associations and several distinguished trial advocacy associations, including the Trial Lawyers of New Jersey, the International Association of Defense Counsel, and the Federation of Insurance and Corporate Counsel. He is a Fellow of the American College of Trial Lawyers, and a Diplomat of the American Board of Trial Advocates.

The Supreme Court of New Jersey, Board of Trial Attorney Certification, has designated Mr. LaVecchia a Certified Civil Trial Attorney.

The award will be presented on September 28 at the Highlawn Pavilion in West Orange.
